Bearing in mind that at least **four preambulatory clauses** are needed. *Realizing* that some delegates may oppose the resolution template. *Guided by* the belief that concordance is necessary in certain situations. *Aware* that there are now four preambulatory clauses, as needed.

- 1. <u>Confirms</u> that at least five operative clauses are needed,
 - **a**. <u>*Emphasizing*</u> that there are no limits to sub-clauses, but that sub-sub-sub clauses are not allowed,
 - b. *Encourages* for double spacing, **12 size font** and concise writing,
 - **c.** *Further supporting* the lack of limits to sub-clauses while discouraging repetition,
- 2. <u>Reminds</u> that no line counts are needed,
- <u>Proclaims</u> that the Best Written Resolution award will go to one that is cogent,
- 4. *Discourages* the use of any informal fonts, except the use of formal fonts such as **Times New Roman**.
- **5.** <u>*Takes note of*</u> how there are now five operative clauses, as needed.
